

**CO-PERMITTEE LIABILITY RELEASE FORM FOR PERMITS
 ASSOCIATED WITH 25 PA CODE CHAPTER 102**

Applicability: This form may be used by a permittee or co-permittee presently covered under an Individual National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activities, the General NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activities (PAG-02), an Erosion and Sediment Control Permit (ESCP), or an Erosion and Sediment Control General Permit for Earth Disturbance Associated with Oil and Gas Exploration, Production, Processing, or Treatment Operations or Transmission Facilities (ESCGP) regardless of when the permit was issued or authorized.

Who May File a Co-Permittee Liability Release Form:

Permittees or Co-permittees, presently covered under a permit referenced above, may submit this release form to the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) or conservation district when the co-permittee is no longer an operator of the construction activity at an unstabilized site.
